Countless sleepless nights passed with dreaming in phonetics. But we are glad to be able to speak and even sing in proper PTH pronunciation. There is so much more to learn though. Pray that as we practice frequently and serve Him more, that our words will bring out His Word with fluency and effectiveness.

Extreme weather is in the news and we are shocked by how humid and damp it gets in HK. The entrance ways are slippery, walls are sweaty, and our clothes in storage got mouldy. Apparently, this is another 10-year record, which reminds us of the record drought in the mainland. Pray for efforts made by Fountainhead to help GX villages build water tanks and piping. Up to now HKD300, 000- has been raised, and pray that the projects can speedily to restore farming and livelihood in these areas.

Our schedules are rearranged for May and June, and we will be teaching in HN on the books of *Psalms* and *Proverbs*. Pray that the materials we prepare will help the local students in their growth and service. Seven of them will graduate from this 2-year training program. Pray also for us since we will be using PTH all along, that we not only communicate well but also can help the students grow spiritually.
