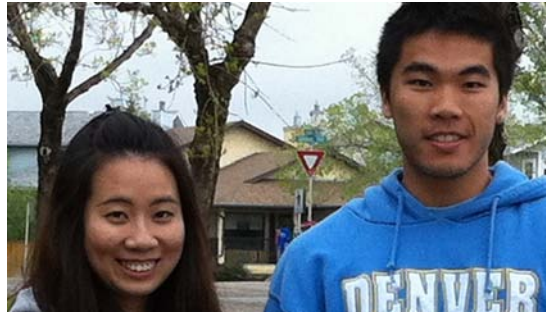
## Wedding
